ADVOCACY LABS – Peer Counseling

- Tool helps to get a better understanding on challenges in specific situations
- In a structured setting
- The person presenting the case has a question or challenge she/he would like to be addressed
- **ROLES:** One presenter
One time & rule keeper
4-5 counsellors
Roles change after each case.

ADVOCACY LAB – Steps

Step 1: presenter reports her case and states the specific question (5')

Step 2: Counsellors ask short questions of clarifications (2')

Step 3: Counsellors build hypotheses. The presenter keeps quiet (8')

Step 4: The presenter reacts to the hypotheses. (3')

Step 5: The counsellors plan interventions. The presenter keeps quiet. (7')

Step 6: The presenter reacts. What does she think? What will she implement? The counsellors keep quiet. (2')
