

Invitation to a webinar: Leaving no one behind

Bangladesh established disability inclusive Disaster Management Committees on Union level (UDMC) and thus contributes to leave no one behind. The established measures save lives and make communities as a whole more resilient. To understand and identify entry points of disability inclusive DRR, CBM co-facilitate a webinar together with a representative of a organization of persons with disabilities (OPD) from Bangladesh on best practice of inclusive programming at field level. The webinar will include the following elements:

- Discussion and identification of entry points.
