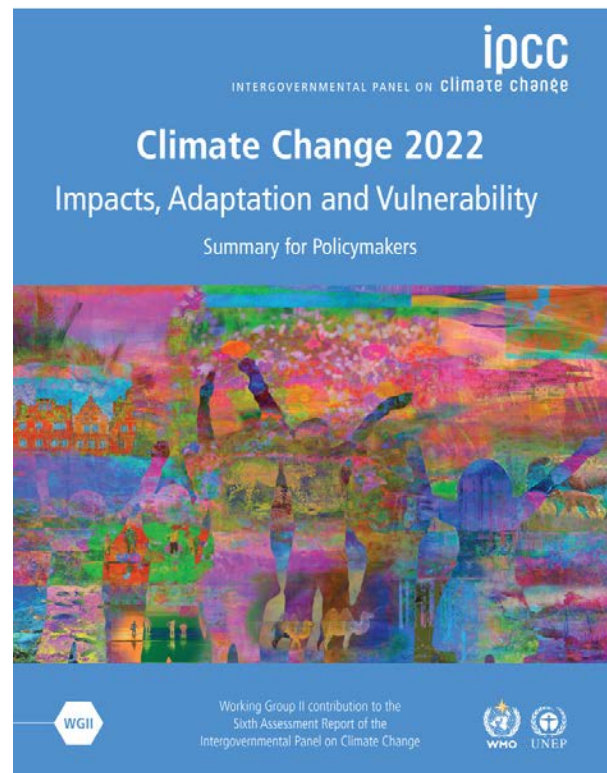

On February 28, 2022, the working group II of the 6th Assessment Report cycle of the IPCC published its latest report on current and future impacts of climate change, adaptation and vulnerabilities.
